

# Stack-n-Slash

**Step #1** - Use 10" squares. Cut the number of squares required for the project you'll be creating!

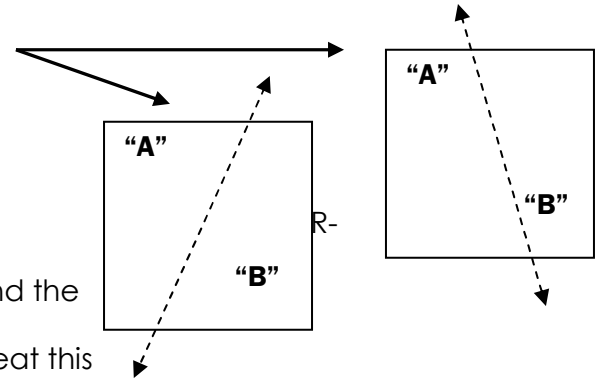
**Step #2** - Separate the squares into piles of 4 different fabrics each.

**Step #3** - Randomly, make the **FIRST CUT** in a diagonal direction.

**Step #4** - Rotate the top piece of Stack "A" to the bottom of its stack.

Stack "B" does not need to be rotated.

**Step #5** - Once Stack "A" has been rotated, sew the first "A" and the first "B" together to create a new 2-fabric block. Repeat this 3 times, keeping the stacks of fabric in order.



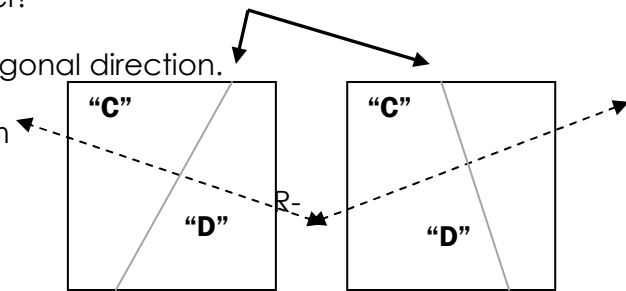
**Step #6** - Press the new blocks and stack them in the same order!

**Step #7** - Randomly, make the **SECOND CUT** in the opposite diagonal direction.

**Step #8** - Rotate the top **TWO** pieces of Stack "C" to the bottom of its stack. Stack "D" does not need to be rotated.

**Step #9** - Once Stack "C" has been rotated, sew the first "C"

and the first "D" together to create a new 4-fabric block. Repeat this 3 times, keeping the stacks of fabric in order.



**Step #10** - Press the new blocks. Square up to 8½" x 8½".

\*NOTE: your blocks may be slightly smaller or slightly larger depending on the direction and the number of cuts you made!!

**Step #11** - Lay the blocks out to make your project! Have fun and Make it Special!!!

\*\*\*You can make more cuts to create a different look with your blocks!!

Just remember, that the more cuts made – the smaller the finished block will become!!
