

### JUST FOR YOU DROP OFF

We are dropping off our J4U quilts at the entrance to the church, under the overhang, then proceeding to parking lot. To expedite the process, please:

1. **DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 9:15 am!** The preschoolers are dropped off until this time. We will try to do 3-4 cars at a time.
2. **SEE REVERSE FOR THE DIAGRAM FOR LINING UP!**
3. **NO ONE ON THE DRIVERS' SIDE OF THE CAR SHOULD GET OUT.** It would be unsafe and we need the driver there, and the car running, for a quick get-away.
4. Have your quilts on the passenger side of the car.
5. If only a few quilts, Pass through the window, if possible, especially if in front of the railings.
6. If you have too many quilts to pass quickly through the window, make sure you are far enough from the curb/railing for someone to get the door open. Also, make sure you know how to quickly unlock the passenger door (usually the gear in "PARK"). If in the trunk area, make sure you can get it open without turning off the car.
7. Tell the runner/tally keeper how many quilt(s) you have.
8. Proceed to the parking lot. Park. **Pick up your pin/donor letter at the membership table- both will be in the envelope.**
9. We will have a table set up in the usual entrance, with a tally person and runner, for those who forget, or feel the line is too long.

**PRESENTATION SET UP- RUNNER AND DISPLAYERS:** Be in the sanctuary at 9:00 am for last minute instructions.

**WASHERS:** Instructions for washing will be at the presentation and they are also on the website. See me if you are not sure how the bagged quilts need to appear for CHOA delivery. Bags will be at the presentation in April - 5 to 6 quilts per bag. Bring the washed, folded, and bagged quilts to the Just 4 You Bee Group April 25 or May 23 at In Town Quilters 10:00 am-2:00pm; or bring the quilts to our guild meeting May 3 or June 19. You can also bring the quilts to Theresa Schultz or Bonnie Cox. Call first to make arrangements. Our contact information is in the directory. June 19 is the **LAST** day I can accept quilts.
