STRIP BUTTERFLIES QUILT

from Missouri Star Quilt Co. Tutorial

- For each block: 3 different bright, coord <u>prints</u> (light, med, dark), cut 2-1/2" X WOF; <u>background</u> (white) 8 squares 2-1/2", 1 strip 1-1/2" X 12-1/2"
- Sew strips together: down one side, up the other--prevents "bowing" of the strips
- · Press strips & cut into 6-1/2" segments
- To create wings: "snowball" opposite corners: (upper R & lower L, lower R & upper L--see diagram)
- Arrange blocks according to diagram. Sew upper wings to lower wings. Sew 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip to center of wings.
- Block size: 13" W X 12" L--arrange in 3 X 4 setting;
 completed guilt size: 54 X 65"

Sashing: cut 2"

Outer border: cut 4", cut 6 strips WOF

· Yardage:

7/8 yard each of 3 prints
1/2 yard background (white)
cornerstones: cut 20: 2" squares
outer border 3/4 yard
binding 1/2 yard
