

# Simply Rows

Estimated finished size 40"x52"

Assorted coordinating fabrics strips (any width that works),  
but full width of fabric needed (40-42").

1 5/8 yd for backing

3/8 yd for binding



Sew as many strips together as needed to make the quilt at least 50" long. The strips can be all the same width or varying. They could also be pieced. When completed, press and trim the sides as wide as possible.

Hint: When you have 60" of strips (std. dressmaker tape length) cut edge to cut edge, the length should be okay, even with the seams.

This is easily quilted on a standard sewing machine. Try using a decorative stitch, squiggle or zig-zag. Quilt one direction only! In the ditch is most difficult, so try stitching on the ditch or next to the ditch. There should be quilting no further apart than 4." This may mean some rows will have stitching down the middle. Try Free motion quilting or with the presser foot, a slight curve down the middle.
