Denise Russell is coming to us from Kennesaw, GA and will be presenting a Trunk Show & program on, "I Love Fabric Panels: How Can I Design a Quilt Using Them." Denise will show us how to figure out what to do with a Panel, how much fabric to purchase, and so on. She will talk about what to focus on when designing a panel quilt.

Carol designs quilts for fabric manufacturers from the US and Canada, for magazines and books. She also publishes patterns under the label "Pieced Brain." She has been blogging about quilting, quilt designs, machine applique, free-motion quilting, and other crafts since 2013. She taught classes at the Grand Rapids AQS Show this past September.

MARCH'S PROGRAM:

Nancy McNally from nancymcnallyquilts.com



Nancy has lectured and taught at several AQS shows this past year.

Nancy McNally will zoom into our March Guild meeting from Michigan to talk to us about how she designs quilts and the messes she has gotten herself into. She will discuss how she works with color, batiks, and longarm quilting. Nancy will share with us how she tweaks a pattern, keeps the eye moving across the quilt, adding a border by bringing in an element from the block out into the border. Nancy says that when she first was introduced to quilting by 3 friends, she had no idea you

could buy fabric, cut up in small pieces, sew back together and create a masterpiece! She was hooked!

She designs patterns, blogs and publishes. She produces "How To" videos on making a quilt from scratch to finish, Bargello quilts, stain glass quilts curved piecing and more! Nancymcnallyquits.com

Nancy Mahoney, International Teacher



Nancy has enjoyed making quilts for over 35 years, during which time an impressive range of her beautiful quilts have been featured in over 250 quilt magazines and authored 15 books since 2002. The newest book is <u>A New Twist</u>. Nancy has designed 15 fabric collections, including eight reproduction collections. She has taught at several AQS Shows, most recently in Daytona Beach, FL in February and Branson, MO in March. Coming up in July she will teach at a Shipshewana Retreat.

Her Program for us, titled "Two Block Wonders", will show how to place two different blocks side by side to create extraordinary quilts. She will show us that every quilter can make unique quilts. Nancy will share her quilts with us and tips for successfully pairing-up blocks to create dazzling results.



Wednesday, April 17 Feathered Star Workshop with Nationally known instructor Nancy Mahoney

Nancy is a sought after nationally known instructor. She is currently teaching a similar class at AQS in Daytona for \$125. Our class is a DEAL. Please support our guild as we host Nancy for this special occasion!

Nancy Mahoney will teach a class on making a feathered star block. The 44" x 44" block can stand alone as a wall hanging or put 4 blocks together to create a stunning quilt. You

will learn cutting and piecing techniques for making accurate triangle squares. Cost is \$45 and includes the pattern. The class will be held at Cannon Methodist Church 9:00-3:00
